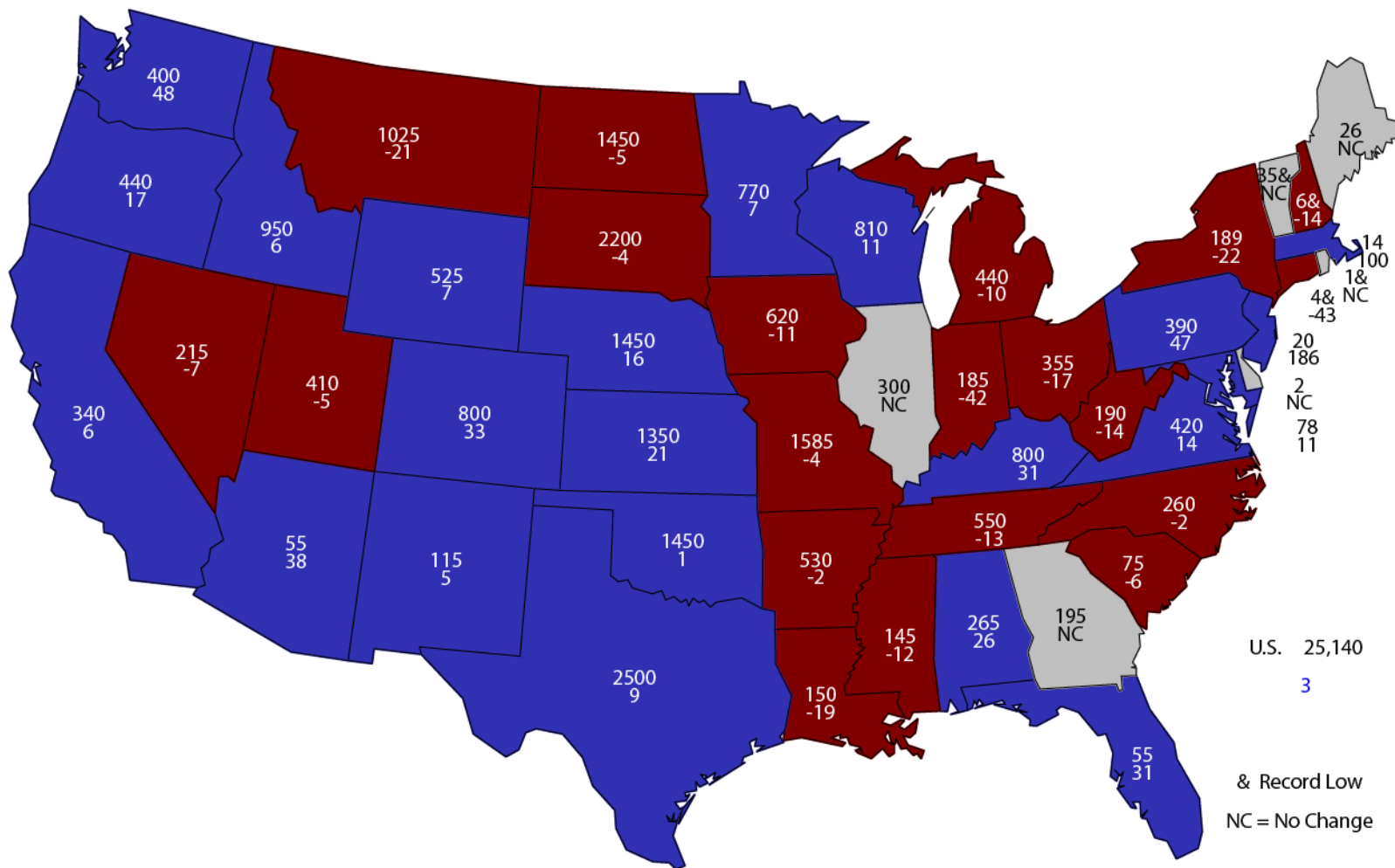

(000) Tons and Percent Change From Previous Year

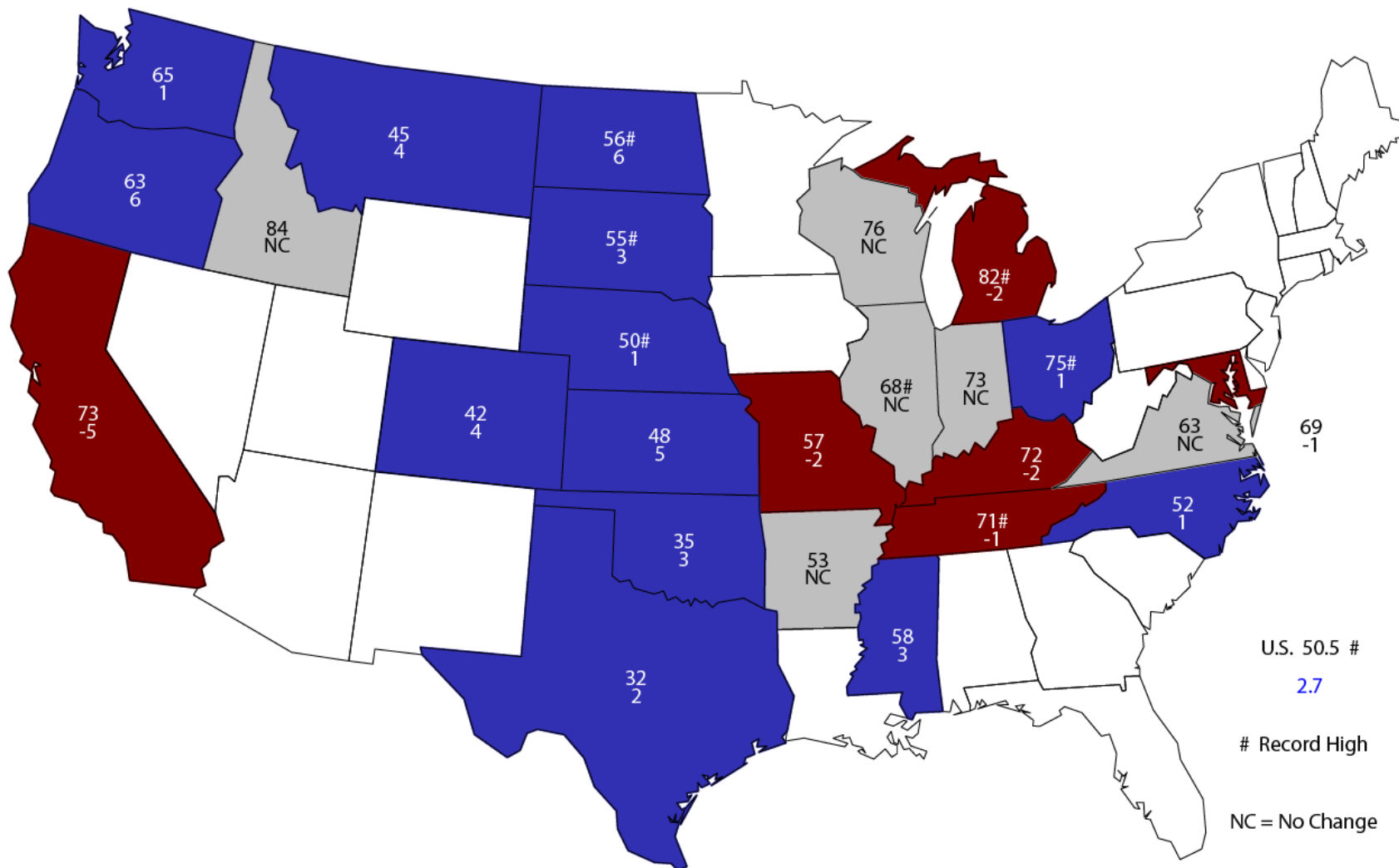

NEBRASKA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

Lincoln, NE – Based on June 1 conditions, Nebraska's 2016 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 62.5 million bushels, up 36 percent from last year's crop, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 50 bushels per acre, up 12 bushels from a year earlier. If realized this would be a new record yield.

Acres to be harvested for grain is estimated at 1.25 million acres, up 40,000 acres from a year ago. This would be 93 percent of the planted acres, above last year's 81 percent harvested.

Crop Progress and Condition

- Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 1 percent very poor, 2 poor, 18 fair, 65 good, and 14 excellent. Corn silking was 1 percent, equal to last year, and near the five-year average of 2.
- Soybeans condition rated 0 percent very poor, 2 poor, 20 fair, 66 good, and 12 excellent. Soybeans blooming was 8 percent, near 7 last year, and equal to the average.
- Winter wheat condition rated 3 percent very poor, 9 poor, 25 fair, 50 good, and 13 excellent. Winter wheat coloring was 90 percent, ahead of 80 last year and 71 average. Harvested was at 4 percent, near 1 last year, but behind 9 average.



Crop Progress and Condition

- Alfalfa condition rated 3 percent very poor, 3 poor, 12 fair, 67 good, and 15 excellent. Alfalfa second cutting was 12 percent, near 11 last year, but behind 22 average.
- Pasture and range conditions rated 1 percent very poor, 2 poor, 16 fair, 67 good, and 14 excellent. Stock water supplies rated 0 percent very short, 4 short, 93 adequate, and 3 surplus.
