

(000) Acres and Change From Previous Year



(000) Acres and Change From Previous Year





Acreage Intentions vs. Actual Planted Acres


Usual Planting Progress



Bushels and Change From Previous Year



Crop Progress and Condition 6/02/19


- **Field Crops Report:** Corn condition rated 1 percent very poor, 2 poor, 23 fair, 67 good, and 7 excellent. Corn planted was 88 percent, behind 99 last year and 98 for the five-year average. Emerged was 67 percent, well behind 90 last year and 88 average.
- Soybeans planted was 64 percent, well behind 94 last year and 87 average. Emerged was 39 percent, well behind 74 last year and 60 average.
- Winter wheat condition rated 2 percent very poor, 6 poor, 25 fair, 48 good, and 19 excellent. Winter wheat headed was 45 percent, well behind 67 last year and 75 average.




Crop Progress and Condition 6/02/19

- Sorghum planted was 36 percent, well behind 77 last year and 70 average.
- Oats condition rated 1 percent very poor, 3 poor, 35 fair, 56 good, and 5 excellent. Oats planted was 96 percent, near 100 both last year and average. Emerged was 88 percent, behind 96 last year and 98 average. Headed was 14 percent, well behind 36 last year, and behind 33 average.
- **Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 1 percent very poor, 1 poor, 15 fair, 70 good, and 13 excellent.


Nebraska Corn Weekly Planting Progress




US Weekly Corn Planting Progress




Corn Percent Planted by State as of June 2




Nebraska Soybean Weekly Planting Progress
